What can we know?




Any apparent contradiction between the Bible and science is a misunderstanding of one or the other.


What is Science?

The intellectual and practical activity encompassing the systematic study of the structure and behavior of the physical and natural world through observation and experiment


This isn't the only way to do science



We are ALL Scientists



- Observation: My cell phone is plugged in, but isn't charging
- Hypothesis: The lightning cord I spent \$3 on stopped working
- Experiment: Try a brand new cord
- Observation: My cell phone still isn't charging
- Hypothesis: The charger block is faulty
- Experiment: Try a charger block that you know works
- Observation: My cell phone still isn't charging
- Conclusion: Apple products are overrated

- Experimental results need to be trusted
- Experimental results need interpretation
- Experimental results need wisdom
- Experimental results need to be cautious


Does the Age of the Universe Matter?
