- 2. We want to move beyond providing symptomatic relief for those who struggle and instead provide **life-changing solutions** for the causes behind their struggles.
- 3. We want to become a "**staging area**" to serve our Brentwood community.

- 4. We want to discern what it means to be a **safe and nurturing church** for all people regardless of their sexual orientation.
- 5. As a means to become a more inclusive and diverse community of believers, we want to **consider gender and** race along with giftedness in hiring decisions for ministers and staff.
