## **OCCC Sr. Camp Camper Expectations & Guidelines**

Campers, We Expect You To ...

- ...Engage: Whether mixer games or solo-time...Crafts or Worship, we expect you to actively engage.
- ... Have a Good Attitude: When things don't go exactly as you envisioned: make the most of it.
- ...Treat Every Person w/Dignity & Respect: This applies to words, actions & attitudes...and it applies to all. A spirit of exclusion or cliquishness has the potential to ruin our week. Please take care to treat others as you would have them treat you. Ugliness, meanness, bullying or pranks will absolutely not be tolerated.
- ...Trust Your Leaders Enough to Follow Them: Counselors and other camp leaders are in place to help keep you safe, make it a great week & provide an opportunity for you to grow spiritually. We expect you to respond positively to the direction they give. Our hope is that God will use these mentors in a special way.
- ...Keep The Focus Where It Belongs: OCCC exists, ultimately, to help students develop the kind of living faith in God that will last. Our assumption is that you know this and that you also want it. Whether this means keeping proper perspective on the game field, taking care to follow the OCCC Dress Code or taking your quiet time seriously, we expect you to join us in keeping God at the center of this special week.

## OCCC Sr. Camp Guidelines:

- "Lights Out" will be strictly enforced.
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco, fireworks or weapons of any kind are allowed at camp.
- In order to prevent unwanted distractions, personal electronic devices (phones, iPods, etc.) are permitted in cabins only. (Note: if any electronic device becomes a distraction, it may be prohibited in cabin as well.)
- Because, we all have our own definition of "modesty", it is important to communicate a few dress guidelines. We love you like crazy and we hope you love yourself. However, in an effort to help keep the focus where it belongs (e.g. on God, not our bodies), students are asked to comply with the following:
